“Tranquility” is a tension between frustration and a muted sense of optimism. The track urges listeners to sit with discomfort and seek out glimpses of hope in the noise.

The emotional honesty is what makes “Tranquility” compelling. The track has a compelling urgency and draws on feelings of discontent and restlessness that many listeners will instantly identify with.
